For over ten years storyteller Cheryl Thornton has brought her K - 8 drama and storytelling programs to schools throughout Southern Ontario.

Cheryl Thornton has created an engaging interactive drama and storytelling program for JK - Grade 1 classes exploring the season of autumn.

The 60-minute program weaves together folktales from around the world, inviting participation through active listening and dramatization...and everyone gets a turn!

The multicultural stories told during the presentation illustrate several strong cooperative communities, supporting positive learning environments.

Children listen to stories from Russia, Australia, France, and Canada and help make a pot of **stone soup!**

The presentation also includes free access to **Storyvalues**, Cheryl's online storytelling program,

where students are challenged to take *The Storyteller's Journey*, exploring folktales, art and music through videos, games and puzzles.

The digital program is a great way for schools and families to strengthen literacy by learning and sharing stories from around the world!
