

Storyvalues presents: Cheryl Thornton's *Tales Along the Pioneer Trail*

An interactive storytelling and drama presentation for grade 3 classes exploring the settlers and First Nations.

Cheryl Thornton has developed an engaging storytelling and drama program for grade 3 classes studying early settlers and First Nations.

The 60-minute interactive presents stories set in pioneer times and myths from Canadian First Nations. Students dress up as animals and characters to help dramatize the stories while using props and instruments to help enter the enchanting world of folk tales, myths and make believe.

Students delight in listening to a funny folk tale about a magical green gourd, a myth about the discovery of corn and help solve riddles in camp fire stories.

The presentation also includes free access to **Storyvalues**, Cheryl's online storytelling program, where students are challenged to take *The Storyteller's Journey*, exploring folktales, art and music through videos, games and puzzles.

The digital program is a great way for schools and families to strengthen literacy by learning and sharing stories from around the world.
